## Be joyful always. Pray continually. Give thanks in all circumstances for this is God's will for you in Christ

Jesus, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

As Christians, this verse can be hard to embrace when life is not going well, yet it is possible and real with Christ Jesus. This is an amazing part about being in the family of God. unreached. Africa Inland Mission vision is Christ-centered churches among all African people and our priority are the unreached.







The San Bushman are one of those unreached people groups. Most live at the very bottom of the social scale in poverty. They have been discriminated against their rights as a group. Their cultural identity has been degraded and has contributed to low self-esteem, apathy, promiscuity, and alcoholism, particularly among the youth. They have been forced into settlements and are dependent upon governmental aid. Many just eat what they call "pap" made out of maize meal for every meal and live in tents. They worship their dead ancestors.

Many African cultures believe when bad things happen, it is their ancestors punishing them for something. They live in constant fear and turn to witchdoctors for help to appease their ancestors. There is no joy or reasons to be thankful.

CHRIST is ALIVE!!! He is not a dead ancestor to appease. Christ has already paid our debt in full. Christ proclaims **YOU** are worth it with wide open arms! Christ wants to bring each one of us abundant life. Christ can fill you up to overflowing with joy, thankfulness, and hope in all circumstances. This is only possible in Christ.

The San Bushmen are **worth the cost**. God desires the San to come to the saving knowledge that Christ died on the cross for them too. They are worth the cost of discipleship.

We are excited that God has called us to **DO SOMETHING NOW!** We are laying aside the American dream for God's dream to see all nations, people groups, worshipping Him.
God has called us to step out of our comfort zone into the part He has for us to play in His beautiful story of redemption among the San. This is beyond ourselves and we have to be completely dependent on HIM. We also need the love and support of family and friends. What part does God want you to play in bringing the Good News to the San Bushman?
